Your teachers can set you work in Google Classroom that you can do on a computer, a tablet or many other devices. You will be taught how to use Google Classroom safely and sensibly but you need to agree to use it the right way.

Your Responsibilities

You will need to:

- Complete your learning either online or by doing it in your book/on paper and asking a parent or carer to take a photo of it. Your parent/carer will help you send it back.
- Do your best in all of your activities.
- Read the comments your teacher have made on your work (with the help of parents/carers).

Your Safety

You must make sure that you:

- Always ask permission before going on the internet and be supervised online.
- Only share your username and password with your parents/carers.
- Only login using your own username and password.
- Do not share e-mail, home address or phone number with anyone, even your classmates.
- Only send messages to your teachers, not other pupils, unless your teacher tells you to.
- If you see anything that makes you feel upset or worried, tell your parents and teachers. They will help you.

Respecting Others

Respect others by:

- Being polite, friendly, and encouraging to teachers and other pupils.
- Only ever work on your own documents, never open anyone else's.

Remember, your teachers will check your account to keep you safe. Be responsible, be safe, be respectful.
