News from our classes

Bowland We had an exciting visit from Lancashire Fire and Rescue this week! The firefighters brought their fire engine to school, and we even got the chance to spray water from one of the hoses — it was so much fun! They showed us the incredible equipment they use to rescue people and animals, and we learned about how firefighters keep us safe. We also got to sit in the back of the fire engine and talk about what to do if there's ever a fire. The firefighters demonstrated their special protective gear, explaining that it's much heavier than their regular uniform because it's made from special materials designed to keep them safe during a rescue.

Grizedale We have had a lovely first week back! This week we have been learning about the Water Cycle. We have learnt a very very catchy song and some actions to help us remember each of the stages. In English, we have started learning all about the Loch Ness monster and are very excited to be writing an article to answer the question 'does the Loch Ness monster exist'? In Computing, we have started our unit on sequencing sound using Scratch. This week we have reminded ourselves how to add sprites, backdrops, movement blocks, sound blocks and how to change a sprite's costume.
