News from our classes

Bowland This week Bowland Class have gone back in time! EYFS loved exploring castles around the U.K and designed their own modern day castle. KS1 have learnt all about 3 Queens- Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. We can't believe how much the children know already! KS1 acted out many parts of the queen's reigns and have designed their own postage stamps today. They had to "Prove It!" using sources of evidence and also learnt about our current King. In English KS1 children have innovated " That's not my dragon" showing super spelling and punctuation. EYFS orally innovated too- so many different stories to be heard... Evie told a story about a unicorn!

Grizedale This week Grizedale have been learning and revisiting formal addition. After learning the method, they worked as teachers and learners to help make it sticky and complete some tricky maths problems. In English, we have been writing our character description for a new villainous witch or wizard. We were blown away at how spooky and detailed they were! In music, we have been learning a new piece of music using the B A and G notes.

Nicky Nook We have been creating our Christmas card artwork and have produced some fantastic work. Did you know that 'Little People, Big Dreams' have not created a book about Walt Disney? We are writing to them to try and persuade them to add him to their collection. We are learning new methods for dividing numbers and we have had to be very resilient! In computing we have been exploring flat-file databases using AND and OR to search.

In November 2024, Finn, one of the club's leading junior players, and Cumbria U14 captain was diagnosed with an aggressive malignant brain tumour.

Since then, Finn has had 4 major brain surgery operations and completed 4 months of chemotherapy and 3 weeks of intensive radiotherapy. He is currently undergoing physiotherapist and occupational health support, hoping to return to playing cricket. He is yet to return to full time schooling.

During his time in hospital Finn had incredible support from his medical team, including the Teenage Cancer Trust. They helped him through the most difficult times imaginable.

The support he has had from the cricket community, family, friends, school and the TCT has been simply phenomenal.
