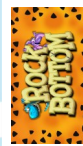
A message from Mrs. Scholz

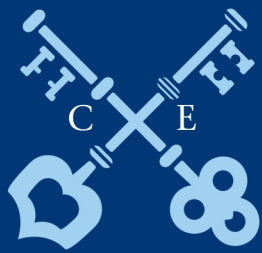
Lead Learners
