News from our classes

Bowland This week in Bowland we have been super busy learning about spring, we have been looking at how we can keep bodies healthy. We have been making and preparing healthy snacks, and talking about what foods help to keep our bodies healthy. Reception have been learning tricky words and sounds. In PE we were looking at old fashioned playground games and the children loved this. We have created our own stories creating story maps about landing on the moon. Year 1 and Year 2 have been historians creating their own timelines to tell the story of Neil Armstrong landing on the moon and Amelia Earhart flying a plane across the Atlantic.

Grizedale This week Grizedale Class have started their Schools 2041 Project. We are going to be learning all about Antarctica, why it is so special and the things we can do to protect it. So far, we have learnt about Olive and her journey to Antarctica. She had to travel for nearly three full days to get there and used two planes, a boat and a very strong dinghy to get there! In English, we have continued learning about 101 Dalmatians and have focused on the infamous villain Cruella De Vil. On Thursday, we innovated a song about the Grinch to match Cruella's characteristics. In Science, we have been learning more about plants and have explored how water is transported through a plant using celery and food-colouring in water to watch as the roots absorb the water and the water travel through the stem.

Nicky Nook This week we have been learning about the Industrial Revolution. We looked at sources of evidence to help us gain knowledge and then considered how reliable these were. On Tuesday we welcomed a visitor to talk about Judaism. We asked lots of questions. It has been lovely to be able to play on the grass this week. We responded to the listening calendar for March in our sketch books.
