Bowland

This week Bowland have been busy learning about the Great Space Race, we learnt what year it was and how long ago it was in decades. Reception have been learning new graphemes that link with space, such as zoom and moon, we have been performing our own moon landing using the famous phrase "one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind" and learning how to write it. Bowland have been resourceful racoons building their own spaceships out of the junk modelling materials, like Apollo 11. Year 1 and 2 have been creating superhero poems using similes such as "as fast as a flash" and "as powerful as a dragon". In Maths we have been practicing multiplications.

Grizedale

This week in Grizedale class we have enjoyed starting our new English unit of work based on the story, '101 Dalmatians' by Dodie Smith. We have been reading/watching the beginning of the film and have written diary entries as Pongo. We have also commenced our Science unit on plants. We have thought about what plants need to grow effectively and have set up plants around the classroom restricting certain variables to investigate what happens over time. Finally we have had a Comic Masterclass with Kev Sutherland - we all loved creating our own characters and producing our own comic strips!
