EYFS loved innovating their bear hunts using the story shelf. In Maths the children have been learning about division with lots of Maths Talk about their strategies to solve problems. In History, we wrote a magazine all about the Anglo-Saxons, in English we wrote storm-inspired haiku poems and in RE we have written a non-chronological report about Judaism.
