This week Oscar is our Lead Learner, he is AMAZING at retelling the story of the Gingerbread Man and he has worked so hard on writing his name.

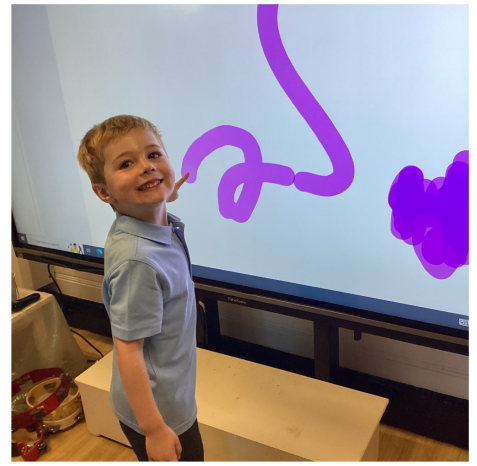
Grizedale Class:
