## News from our classes

### Bowland

What a busy week in Bowland! KS1 children have written their own versions of George and the Dragon including Ava and the Komodo Dragon! We are so proud of their singing, writing and brilliant ideas! Reception children have started to write sentences using their tricky words- so much amazing writing based on "Room on the Broom" this week. In Maths Reception have made teen numbers in different ways and compared two numbers to 20. KS1 children enjoyed using the bead strings to make numbers to 100, practising using the < and > symbol. All of the children worked together in teams to make an Amazon Rainforest. The children composed songs, compared physical and human features and are expert Geographers using atlases and globes.

In History this week we were analysing sources that would help us to answer the question 'is it fair to call Vikings brutal raiders and traders?'. We looked at a range of sources to investigate the Viking raid on Lindisfarne and used a Horrible Histories song to find out how brutal they were!
