News from our classes



Bowland This week Bowland Class learnt all about how to keep healthy. They investigated how humans change as they mature and worked together scientifically to gather data. EYFS children have been very busy recalling number bonds, subitising and counting beyond 20! They have practised using finger spaces, forming letters and placing them on the line. KS1 children have had great fun innovating Jack and the Jelly Bean stalk and solving mixed Maths problems. The children have been practising lots ahead of Sports Day and cannot wait!

Grizedale This week in maths we have been working really hard on our individual big maths targets in class as well as revisiting our learning on angles. In RE, we have continued learning about how Jesus changed/ changes lives. We learnt about the story of, 'The Rich Young Man' from the Bible and came up with our own modern versions of the phrase, 'it is easier for a camel to fit through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God'. In addition to this, we have been busy with play rehearsals this week! We have been working on our expression and volume and making sure that we can be heard from the back of the church.
