News from our classes

Bowland This week Bowland Class have enjoyed comparing the religions of Christianity, Islam and Judaism. The children have created mosques in the blocks area, drew mosques around the world, used Google Earth to locate mosques, role played Eid in the home corner and wrapped presents for Eid! They have also discovered the meaning of the crescent moon and star for Muslim boys and girls and thought about new beginnings in their life. The children made connections and remembered lots about Judaism and Christianity too.

Grizedale We have started our new science unit of Living Things and Their Habitats and learnt some actions to help us remember the process of MRS GREN. In History, we have started learning about the Anglo-Saxons and have done some source analysis using videos, text and maps to help us find out where they came from, when they came to Britain and why they migrated! In PE this week we have started our new learning called 'trust and trails', this week, we had to work as teams to create different letters and shapes with our bodies and then guide our partner around school whilst they had their eyes closed!
